



The above chart is based on Samuel Sr's Will – Culpeper County Will Abstracts Book B,C. The order of birth is unknown and probably is different from that shown above.

(1) Will of Samuel Fargeson of Culpeper Co.

Dated 15 Feb., 1772. Proven 18 May, 1772.

Legatees: “Lands and slaves in the possession of Elizabeth Fargeson, widow of my son Francis Fargeson, dec'd, be disposed of in the manner he directed by his will”. Wife: Ann Fargeson. Sons: Samuel Fargeson. Daus.: Elizabeth Fargeson, Susanna Daniel, Ann wife of Francis Strother, Lucy wife of John Graves, Grandson: Benjamin Fargeson, son of my son Francis Fargeson. Granddau.: Elizabeth Daniel. Grandsons: Samuel Clayton, George Clayton and Phillip Clayton, sons of a deceased dau. Granddau.: Elizabeth Pendleton. Grandaus.: Ann Fargeson and Susanna Fargeson, daus. Of son Francis Fargeson, dec'd. Grandson: Samuel Fargeson, son of my son Samuel Fargeson.

Executors: Wife Ann Fargeson, son Samuel Fargeson

Wit.: Henry Pendleton, James Pendleton

(2) Aug. 13, 1760. Inventory of Benjamin Fargeson, dec'd, filed.

(3) “18 March 1762. This receipt from Benjamin Fargeson, deceased, to Samuel Fargeson his father was exhibited by Samuel. Ordered to be recorded in order preserve the same, the witnesses not being present.” – Culpeper County, Virginia Deeds, Vol Two 1755-1762.

(4) April 19, 1770. Samuel Fargeson the Elder of St. Mark's Parish for love and affection to Sarah Fargeson, widow of my son, Benjamin, dec'd., and William Pendleton and Betty, his wife, my grand daughter and daughter of the said Sarah Fargeson and my son, Benjamin, dec'd., 350 acres in Gourd Vine Fork of the Rappahannock River.

(5) William Pendleton (Nathaniel, Henry, Philip), b. Jan 13,1748 d Mar 31,1817 in Berkeley Co. Va. William was a Culpeper Minute Man during the Revolution. He was married twice. 1st April 17,1770 Elizabeth Ferguson b Oct 10, 1756 d Aug 15,1799, the daughter of Benjamin and Sarah Anne Fargeson. Benjamin son of Samuel and Anne Brown Fargeson. And 2nd married Elizabeth Daniel b Feb 2,1749 d Aug 6,1808, of Culpeper Co., Va. She was daughter of Robert and Susannah Fargeson Daniel. She was first cousin to his first wife.
